Sustainability, Climate Change Mitigation and Digitization Efforts at AMUL

Shri Amit Vyas, Managing Director, Amul Dairy



Mr. Amit Vyas leads the pioneering co-op Dairy of India which laid the foundation of financial independence and self-reliance for the Indian Dairy Farmers. He has overseen consistent double digit growth at AMUL and introduced revolutionary initiatives in areas of cost savings, energy conservation, automation & digitalization. Initiatives driven by him from villages to the dairy plants have resulted in reduction of total carbon emission by 52216 MT/Annum. Recent accolades for AMUL and Mr. Vyas include the Golden Peacock Award for innovative and sustainable energy conservation, the National Energy Conservation Award, Animal Health Leadership Award and CII - National Award for excellence in Energy Management (2023).

Dr. Verghese Kurien, the architect of the largest dairy development program in the world and the past leader at AMUL, is a Michigan State University alumnus.
